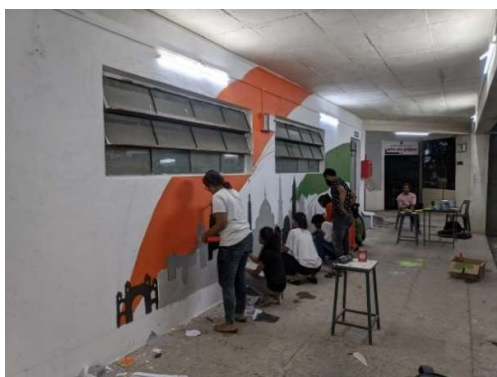




Students participation in Wall painting Competition

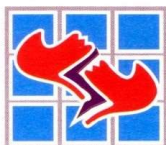
